**Friday, September 7 – *The Good Lie*.** Reese Witherspoon stars in this overlooked gem from 2014, the story of Sudanese refugees struggling to make a better life for themselves in the U.S. Mira Mendick, Community Relations Director at Lutheran Social Services and Kathryn Tobias, local refugee support volunteer, will be on hand to place this film in the context of our burgeoning refugee community in the DC area.

**Friday, October 12 – *My Architect*.** This Academy Award-nominated documentary from 2003 celebrates the life and work of the great American architect, Louis Kahn, who died bankrupt and alone in 1974. It's also the story of his estranged son, Nathaniel, who made this unique film as a way to better know and understand him. Katherine Soffer, personal acquaintance of the filmmaker, will introduce the film.

**Friday, November 2 – *Dave*.** We celebrate Election Day with this endearing comedy from a more innocent time (1993) about an idealist who accidentally becomes President. If you missed this summer's Broadway-bound musical version of this film – or even if you didn't – here's your chance to join the fun, and maybe feel a little more hopeful about the future of our democracy!

**Friday, December 7 – *Joyeux Noël*.** We mark the centennial of the armistice ending World War I – and the Holiday season – with this feature from 2006. Based on an actual event on the Western Front in 1914 when enemy soldiers climbed out of the trenches to celebrate Christmas with each other, this moving film testifies to the power of "peace on earth, good will to all people" -- even in the midst of the most terrible war the world had ever seen.
